

Rx Mission Drive-in/Drop-Off prescription drug program addresses a vital public safety and public health issue. More than seven million Americans currently abuse prescription drugs, according to the 2009 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration's National Survey on Drug Use and Health. Each day, approximately, 2,500 teens use prescription drugs to get high for the first time according to the Partnership for a Drug Free America. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including the home medicine cabinet.

To help combat this growing threat to our people, the Somerset County Sheriff's Office, U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, in conjunction with the Somerset County Solid Waste Management Division's Household Hazardous Waste program, are partnering to host **Rx Mission Drive-In/Drop-Off** on Saturday June 9th, 2012.

The drugs collection program is free, anonymous, no questions asked initiative which prevents pill abuse and theft by ridding homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted prescription drugs. Medicines that languish in home cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse, and abuse.
