Q5	• Please provide a complete list of 170 single-family residences to confirm "collection points."	p. TS-1
Q6	• Is Saturday an acceptable day of the week for the annual June bulk pick up?	p. TS-2
Q7	• Is the total of 'approximately ninety (90) tons of solid waste is being generated each month ' accurate? At that volume, annual collection would be closer to \$100,000 or greater.	p. TS-2
Q8	• Is the collection day flexible? We are not concerned and find Friday to be suitable but wanted to know if there is an option to change it.	p. TS-2
Q9	• Do homeowners have a choice of container size as it appears to be a mix of 64 gallon and 96 gallon throughout the community? Yet, the technical specifications state 'provide one (1) watertight 96 gallon container to each collection point.'	p. TS-2
